Clear data is invaluable in education: You get what you measure.

While there are many tools to measure academic growth, there are few that focus meaningfully on the emotional side. To lead positive change in schools, and to create an evidence-based approach to SEL, metrics are key: metrics about student, teacher, and parent emotional intelligence – and assessment of the school climate as a whole.

EQTE certifies you to administer Six Seconds' normed, validated assessment tools for education:

SEI: Six Seconds Emotional Intelligence Assessment and **SEI 360**.

SEI-YV: for youth ages 7-18.


EVS: Education Vital Signs, the powerful school climate survey.

The EQTE Toolkit

Where other tests provide “diagnosis,” these tools offer insight, plus a powerful framework for putting emotional intelligence into action.

- **SEI:** Emotional intelligence self-assessment for adults includes numerous report options for use in coaching, training, and professional development. Includes Six Seconds EQ Model plus outcomes including: Effectiveness, Health, Relationships and Quality of Life.
- **SEI-YV:** The best-in-class tool for measuring and developing emotional intelligence in youth (ages 7-18). The tool measures EQ linked to life outcomes: Good Health, Relationship Quality, Life Satisfaction, Personal Achievement, and Self-Efficacy.
- **SEI360:** Multi-rater feedback tool for adults on how they are putting the EQ competencies into action.
- **EVS:** The Education Vital Signs (EVS) is a statistically validated, normed assessment of school climate that quickly identifies areas both supporting and interfering with school success. The school climate influences critical outcomes such as thriving, safety, involvement, and learning.

The toolkit also includes introductory presentation materials and sample lessons to assist with the introduction of social emotional learning

Course Agenda

EQTE begins with pre-course work taking the SEI assessment and reading about the model. In the course, we continue with an orientation to the Six Seconds Model and framework for implementing Social Emotional Learning. Then we go into detail on the tools using case studies, practical exercises, and small group projects. Participants complete six short modules in our e-learning site with resources, videos, readings, and discussion forums to support the classwork.

The program continues with post-course coaching and follow-up to practice and apply the tools, and then a final practicum. With this support, participants complete the certification and are quickly able to use the EQ assessments to measure positive change.

- Pre-course work including self-assessment and preparatory e-learning modules.
- Training – either through the in-person course or virtual online course (see below).

Certification Requirements

Certification requires completion of all coursework*; two or three practice debriefs each with the SEI and SEI-YV, one practice debrief with the SEI-360, and one practice use of the EVS; reading & understanding of course materials; demonstration of competence through a final “practicum” (debrief a Six Seconds staff member plus verbal review of key concepts). Additional distance training and practicum will be available at \$100/hr for those who require further study to meet the practicum expectations.

For the virtual program, participation is required in at least 6 of the 7 classes (makeup sessions for missed classes available at \$100/hr).

Certifications must be completed within 90 days of the start of course or as arranged with facilitator.



Virtual Classroom

Blended and Virtual

The “blended” program mixes independent online learning, three highly interactive sessions of in-person classroom training, 1-1 mentoring, and independent practice.

The “all virtual” EQTEv is also available, delivered entirely online for those who prefer a distance-learning format. Either option provides the same content; the blended option adds the “real world” experience, the virtual is more flexible.

The Virtual Classroom provides real-time interaction, we all can see and hear one another and work collaboratively. Between classes, participants work in pairs and independently to deepen, integrate, and apply the learning.

In addition to seven classroom meetings (90 minutes each), participants will engage in 1-3 hours of independent work before each class, plus 5-8 hours of independent work following the last session. The assignments are a mix of working with a partner in the class, independent practice, and reading, and each session utilizes the content from the assignments. Participants will complete six modules on our e-learning site, with videos, readings, resources, and discussion forums. To join, participants will need high-speed internet connection and a microphone & headphone (or headset).
